Approve the minutes from September: moved, seconded, and approved

Chairman's report - Anthony: He went to the first District SCC Leader's mtg. and reported on the presentation about Shared Governance, Land Trust Funding. The question was asked about how the Land Trust Funds should be spent – Anthony reported that the funds had to be spent equitably throughout the school on programs to benefit all students. Marian responded that is why we spend the funds on Art and Math.

LAND Trust reports - Marian: Marian reported that we allocated funds to Shelly Rich's salary, and to pay for ParaPro's to facilitate Math education.

Review "Touch the Future" – Marian: This is a SCC presentation on YouTube about how the Land Trust Funds are to be used. Marian reported that it was off-line for now.

School Emergency Plans – Marian: There will be a letter coming to Anthony about Safe Sheltering in the School. Updated Emergency Plans and information has been distributed to the teachers. The question was asked about how that information would go out to parents. Marian said there would be a notice/letter distributed to parents. We are still trying to get it on the website.

Capital Improvement Plans – Marian: 2017-2018 capital improvements include replacing countertops on the lower floor, replacing carpet (over the next 3 years), HVAC work to replace dampers, control room equipment repair, crack and seal repair and replacement of the asphalt, replacement of the north playground equipment. The District has committed to providing shade and trees for the playground but that has been delayed by a lack of supply of trees on the market.

Kristie asked if there was some way to provide shade structures for the playground and above the windows on the south side of the building. Marian didn't know, but said that she would ask about it.

Jill brought up the question from parents that had inquired about adding time to the lunch period. Marian reported that if we did so it would alter the beginning or end time of school. Changing the schedule would have to begin with SCC and the Faculty, and then go to the District.

#### Reports -

C&A – Kristie: The newsletter has not yet come to pass. The question was asked about who was orchestrating the program meetings. The response was that the program meetings are teacher generated and that the program is more site-based managed. The question was asked about how the name C&A LAB came to be, Marian replied that the program hasn't been working in that manner for some time. Heather B. reported that the program has undergone some changes since its inception that have meant that the "LAB" function has not been fully realized across the District. Ashlee asked if the "School Performance Report card" could show the performance of the individual programs. Marian and Heather B. reported that the data could be disaggregated, but there were issues that should be factored into such. Heather B. did agree that there would be benefit to being able to see the data in that way.

ELP – Heather R.: There is a new Spanish teacher – Ms. Angela. Julie Henderson has indicated that she would like facilitate Love and Logic parenting classes for the school's families. The hope would be to extend the language and discipline strategies between school and home.

Heather also noted that Dr. Cunningham will be coming to Hawthorne for breakfast with the school community on Oct 18<sup>th</sup> from 7-9 am.

Neighborhood – Anthony: Nothing new to report. The traffic still is a problem, particularly in the morning. Reports of traffic concerns can be sent/uploaded to the slcmobile app available to load onto your mobile device.

PTA – Jill: The HawkWalk netted \$7400 for PTA. The Book Fair netted \$1000 for the library, Mr. Nielsen wishes to express his thanks to PTA and the parents who supported the Book Fair. Sonic Drive-In night on Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>.

Movie night on Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>. Dinner for SEP's was successful, the massages offered by Ashly Olsen were successful. RIF distribution coming up.
